- 4. Play each player in at least one half of a game. Remember we want kids to have fun. Winning is a consideration but not our main objective. Encourage all your players to be team players
- 5. Organize practices that are fun and challenging for the players. Familiarize yourself with the rules, techniques, and strategies of soccer
- 6. Have fun, be a role model, and enjoy teaching your players
