3. Give all players an opportunity to improve their skills, gain confidence, and develop self-esteem. Never ridicule, yell, and verbally or physically abuse a player
4. Play each player in at least one half of a game. Remember we want kids to have fun. Winning is a consideration but not our main objective. Encourage all your players to be team players
5. Organize practices that are fun and challenging for the players. Familiarize yourself with the rules, techniques, and strategies of soccer
6. Have fun, be a role model, and enjoy teaching your players
